Participation & Eligibility

All Hartford residents Grades 4th-12th are eligible to participate Non-Hartford residents are eligible to apply if they attend a Hartford based school.

Youth interested in participating will have to submit a 1-3 page essay that discusses the following:

How has violence affected your or someone you know?

What would you do to reduce violence in your community?

Describe your plan in detail.

Whom would you ask for help?

How would you involve the community?

How will your idea make a difference?

Guidelines:

All entries must be typed on standard size paper 8 ½" X 11"

If emailing your essay-please save it as a Microsoft Word document with your last name and name of the school as the file name. All entries must have complete information at the top of the paper: (student's name, complete home mailing address, school, teacher's name, grade, age, and a contact phone number).

Essays should be a minimum of 300 words & not exceed 1,000 words.

Essay must be entrant's original work. Essays that have won other contests or that have appeared in any print or online publications are not eligible.

Judging:

Entries will be evaluated on the basis of content, creativity and how convincing you are Please note that each of the questions must be answered.

Awards for all Grade Levels:

1st place - \$500 2nd place - \$200 3rd place - \$75

All participating students will be acknowledged with a certificate.
